Two airports, Bush Intercontinental and Houston Hobby, service Houston. Since all wedding activities are taking place on the far north side of Houston, it is best to fly into Bush Intercontinental. Let us know if you will need to be picked up or dropped off at the airport and we will be more than happy to make arrangements for you. Also, the wedding ceremony will begin at 11:00 a.m., so arrange you travel plans accordingly.
